Can learner state how to leave a building in case of fire?	Immediately takes nearest exit that is away from fire or smoke, takes stairs instead of elevator, stay near ground if smoky, etc.	4= states and demonstrates how to evacuate when there is smoke or fire and what to do if planned route is blocked, 3= states and demonstrates safe way to evacuate when there is smoke or fire, 2= states need to alert others, to evacuate, and describes potential ways to exit building, 1= states the need to leave in case of fire but requires assistance to evacuate
